Objective / In order to perfect our drawing skills, to expand our art vocabulary and experience, and to learn photography composition, WE WILL draw, visit museums, do scavenger hunts, and use our digital/mobile cameras, and I WILL stay positive and create new things to the best of my ability.

Activities

Student Activities:

WEDNESDAY, MARCH 25

- Send me an <u>email with the subject line</u> (YOUR NAME) Checking In telling me that you're in the course and how you're doing. I put together an art kit for you, available at BAKER JUNIOR HIGH during meal distribution time. It's a bag of map colors and a pencil...it has your name on it. Let me know a) if you've gotten the bag, b) when you might be getting the bag, and c) other art supplies you might have on hand. (I want to get a feel for what you all have to work with, but I'm going to keep the assignments very simple, as in pencil drawings are just fine. Spice them up with the map pencils. If you have other supplies, then fancy them up! Fancy is not required.)
- 2. Go to YouTube and search for Jo Claire Hall—select the DRAWING category.
- 3. Watch the video called "The Drawing Advice That Changed My Life." In this video, the guy tells of a tip that another artist gave him and which he put into practice. After watching, think about your THING to draw...make a plan to draw that THING every day. It could be on a scrap of paper. Get in the habit of taking a picture of your daily thing. It might help if you number them on the back—day 1, day 2, etc...Go ahead and DRAW YOUR THING. Take a picture of it and save it to your computer/phone. Call it thing day 1.

THURSDAY, MARCH 26

- 1. Warm up by drawing YOUR THING—day 2! Take a picture of it and save it to your computer/phone. Call it thing day 2.
- 2. Go to my youtube channel: Jo Claire Hall---go to the DRAWING section.
- 3. Watch the youtube video titled: "The 7 Basic Forms: Box Form Variations."
- 4. Draw along with the video—try to complete all of the drawings that are shown. Take a picture of your work and SUBMIT IT FOR A GRADE.
- 5. In the SUBJECT LINE of your email, put (MY NAME) BOX FORMS---put your name, of course, where it says my name. Remember, I'm going to be getting 50-plus emails with attachments, so I need to know IN THE SUBJECT LINE who is submitting the work and which assignment it is. FAILURE TO FOLLOW THESE DIRECTIONS will result in 5 points off of your grade.

FRIDAY, MARCH 27

- 1. Warm up by drawing YOUR THING—day 3! Take a picture of it and save it to your computer/phone. Call it thing day 3.
- 2. Go to my youtube channel: Jo Claire Hall—go to the PHOTOGRAPHY section.
- 3. There are several videos there, but I'd like for you to <u>watch the first three</u> on the list. This will give you some background and understanding about best-practices for taking awesome photos!
- 4. Watch the fourth video on the list called: "Stay At Home Photography Projects"

- 6. Read the document and follow the directions for the scavenger hunt, finding as many of the items as you can to photograph in a unique/interesting way. Have fun with this!!!
- 7. Create a PowerPoint slideshow (or use another slideshow/video tool of your choice) to share all of your cool photos! SUBMIT THIS FOR A GRADE.
- 8. NOTE: Want an A grade? <u>Include written commentary</u> describing what you were aiming for, challenges you faced, what you like/don't like about that photo, etc... <u>in your presentation</u>.
- 9. In the SUBJECT LINE of your email, put (MY NAME) SCAVENGER HUNT—Be sure to attach your presentation! Failure to follow these directions will result in 5 points off of your grade.
